Group Camping

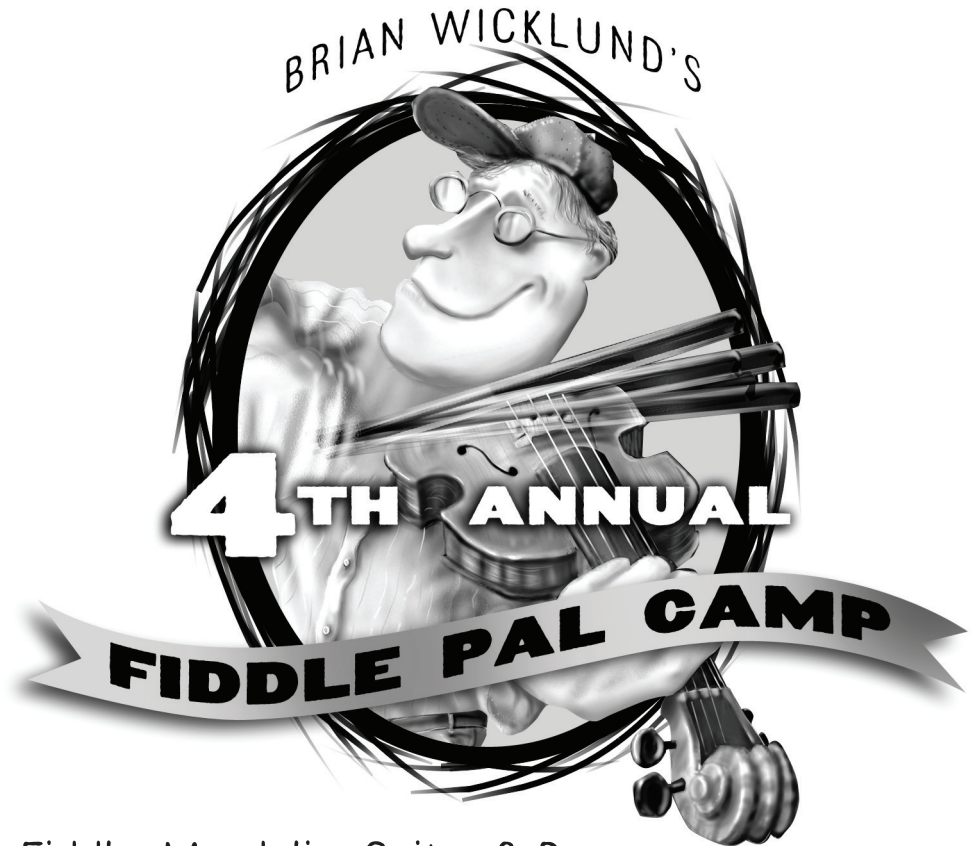
